PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. Only this application form needs to be sent to the Chancery Office if this is the first marriage for each party or if there is no previous spouse living.
- 2. All the prenuptial papers are to be sent to the Chancery Office in the following cases:
 - a. When either party has a previous spouse living;
 - b. When the marriage is to take place in another diocese;
 - c. When the Catholic party does not have domicile or quasi-domicile in the Diocese of La Crosse and does not reside actually in the Diocese.
- 3. Permission of the local ordinary is necessary for a priest or deacon to celebrate a mixed marriage in a non-Catholic Church. i.e., when there has been no dispensation from canonical form and the Catholic marriage rite is to be celebrated. He must also obtain express delegation from the pastor in whose territory the non-Catholic church is located (Can. 1109–1111).
- 4. Catholic marriages are to be celebrated in a church (Can. 1118).
- 5. When officiating at a mixed marriage of a Catholic from another parish, the permission of the Catholic party's pastor is to be obtained (Can. 1115).
