The theme for this year's retreat is "**Thrive!**" We encourage all attendees to reflect upon Proverbs 13:19-25,

Disaster entraps sinners, but God-loyal people get a good life. A good life gets passed on to the grandchildren; ill-gotten wealth ends up with good people. Banks foreclose on the farms of the poor, or else the poor lose their shirts to crooked lawyers. A refusal to correct is a refusal to love; love your children by disciplining them. An appetite for good brings much satisfaction, but the belly of the wicked always wants more."

Cost

The "Early Bird" Price: The "Early Bird" price is \$145 per person. This applies to each person in your group whose forms and money are in our office by the October 30, 2017 deadline. So if you have people register late, for whatever reason, only those late registrations will forfeit the "Early Bird" price and not the entire group. This cost includes: lodging, t-shirt, water park pass, meals, and the retreat itself.

Regular Price: Forms and money that come in <u>after October 30</u> will be charged the regular price of \$165 per person. These people will not be guaranteed a t-shirt, and may be required to bring a sleeping bag to sleep on the floor depending on room capacity.

Transportation to and from the Wilderness Resort, as well as, dinner Friday and lunch on Sunday, will need to be worked out by individual parishes. The rooms sleep four people. Adults will not be staying in the same room as the youth.
