Mite Boxes and Rice Bowls:

We hope to clarify some confusion that has arisen. These two programs are both supported by diocesan offices, however, they need to be understood correctly. **The Mite Box program** is an outreach from the Holy Childhood Association (HCA), one of the Pontifical Mission Societies represented in the Mission Office. Since 1960 Santa Cruz Parish, Bolivia has been a Mission Parish of the Diocese of La Crosse and for many years has been assisted by the efforts of our children in this annual collection. Mite Box is a mandatory program for our Catholic School, CCD and Religious Education programs for children and youth. **The Rice Bowl**

program is an activity sponsored by Catholic Relief Service (CRS). It is organized locally through the Social Concerns Office of the diocese. Rice Bowl is an elective program that may be held any time throughout the year with an emphasis on Lent, but it is not to conflict with or replace the Mite Box program. RCIA Coordinators: Rite of Election Retreat, February 25

In preparation for the Rite of Election and of the Call to Continuing Conversion (March 5), many parishes (or groups of parishes) offer retreats for their catechumens and candidates. For those parishes that do not offer a retreat in the parish, there will be three retreats open to catechumens and candidates on the morning of Saturday, February 25: at St. Peter Parish in Stevens Point, St. Mary Parish in Altoona, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. While the morning's schedule will vary slightly from place to place, each will begin around 8:00 and conclude with lunch at noon. Contents will include:

- Three spiritual talks on 1) the meaning of Lent as a time of preparation for participating in the Paschal Mystery, 2) the meaning of the Apostolic Church and the Church today (in light of their meeting Bishop Callahan, a successor to the apostles), and 3) participating in the Rite of Election, focusing on the questions and prayers it contains.
- Time for private prayer and reflection.
- Mass and group prayer.

Pope Francis Grants Plenary Indulgence for Fatima Centennial

Pope Francis has granted a plenary indulgence opportunity for the 100th anniversary of the Fatima apparitions throughout the centennial year, from the 27th of November 2016 till the 26th of November 2017 (see full information here). In addition to the usual conditions and prayers (confession, Eucharistic communion, detachment from sin, and prayers for the Holy Father), the faithful may make a pilgrimage to the Fatima Shrine or pray before any statue of Our Lady of Fatima:

- 1. To the faithful who visit with devotion a statue of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly exposed for public veneration in any church, oratory or proper place during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions, the 13th of each month from May to October 2017, and there devoutly participate in some celebration or prayer in honor of the Virgin Mary. In addition, the faithful must pray the Our Father, recite the Creed and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.
- 2. To the faithful who, because of age, illness or other serious cause, are unable to get around, may pray in front of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima and must spiritually unite themselves to the jubilee celebrations on the days of the apparitions, the 13th of each month, between May and October 2017. They must also "offer to merciful God with confidence, through Mary, their prayers and sufferings or the sacrifices they make in their own lives."

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.diolc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
