Another Reminder: Religion Assessments for the Parishes are cancelled this year.



DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Diocesan Annual Appeal – Stewards of Hope

We are still working with GivingTrend to get the reporting site back online entirely. Some of the changes are available but still incomplete, and we have not verified and reconciled the data. Please refer to the Appeal Portal for continuing progress updates.

Some Highlights Year to Date: (As of 10/23/2017)

- New Donors, we have 184 donors who have never before given to the Diocesan Annual Appeal, for a total of \$31,644
- SYBUNT Donors we have 386 donors who have re-engaged in giving this year: to the amount of \$49,349
- For the period through the first week after the second mail drop, we are up 14.1% in dollars given. \$2,102 152 vs 1,842,797 (2017 vs 2016 respectively)
- For the same period above the number of donors participating is up 19.4%

We will be sending our LYBUNT mailing reminder to those parishes who had their initial mail drop in September. All donors who gave last year but not yet given this year, as well as any new donors since our last mailing. Those parishes that had their initial mail drop in October will receive a LYBUNT follow-up mailing the week of November 27.

An essential element in the success of the Diocesan Annual Appeal is a supportive priest, appeal committee, and parish staff that continually communicates the value and progress of the appeal positively and excitingly.
