#### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <a href="www.diolc.org">www.diolc.org</a>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <a href="diocesan website">diocesan website</a>. #### BISHOP CALLAHAN'S CHRISTMAS MASS PRAYER INTENTIONS

On Thursday December 8, The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Virgin Mary, parishioners with valid phone numbers listed in ParishSOFT received an automated call from Bishop Callahan, originating from 608-352-9565. The message was a 30-second Advent greeting with an invitation to leave a personal intention. Bishop Callahan will be praying for these intentions at his Christmas Masses. So far he has received over 700 intentions. These prayers will be given to Bishop Callahan. He will offer his Christmas Mass celebrations, both the TV Mass and the Midnight and 10:30 Masses at the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman, for those intentions.

If you have a parishioner who didn't receive a call, or wishes to her the message again, have them either call the number or visit the website. The online form and phone number will remain active for prayer intentions throughout the year, but the Advent message will be removed on December 23.

For all the Parishes and Schools that are now sharing employees /expenses between one another as of January 1, 2017, I have put together a guide as to how the accounting should occur on each of the parish/school records. Please note that when sharing priests, no written agreement is necessary. A written agreement only needs to be in place for the lay employees. Please see the guide attached.
