Lenten Preparations - Good Friday Collection for the Holy Land: This annual collection is a part of the Diocesan Annual Appeal. Therefore, it is not required that parishes of the Diocese of La Crosse take up the Good Friday collection for the Holy Land. However, since we are aware of the adversities suffered by Christians in the Holy Land and the fragile nature of important historical sites they protect, some parishioners do look forward to participating directly in the annual collection. Under the discretion of the pastor and his advisory councils, if the collection is taken up the funds generated must be sent to the Diocesan Office for Temporalities. Parish collections will then be joined to the Annual Appeal funds and forwarded according to donor intent to the Commissariat of the Holy Land. DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>.
