**3:15 pm** – Chaplet of Divine Mercy

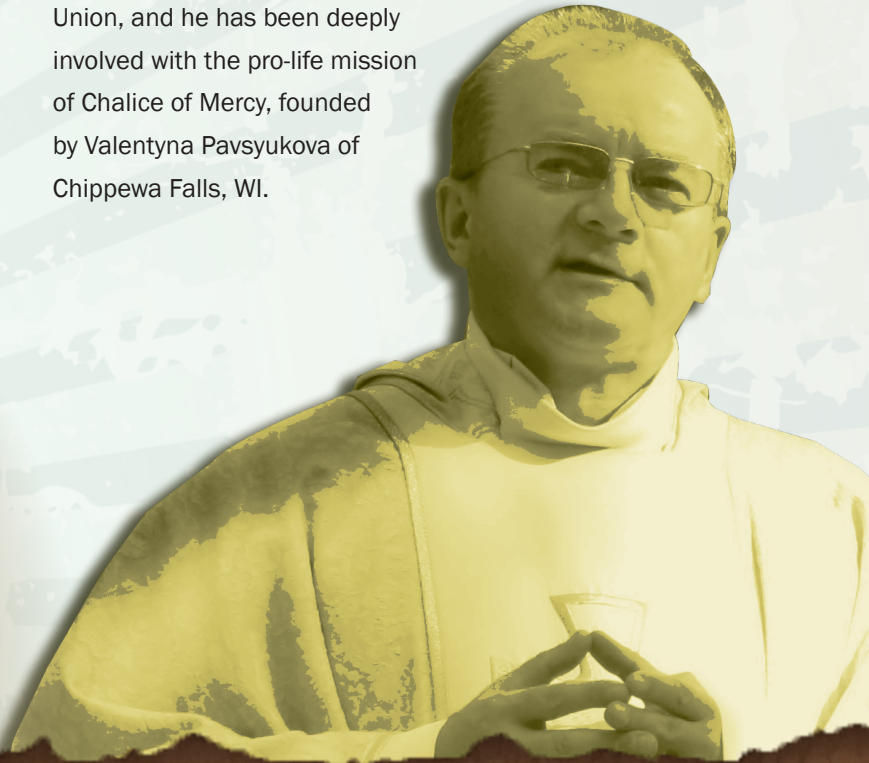
Bishop Jan Sobilo was ordained a priest in Poland in 1986 at the age of 24. As a young priest he volunteered to leave his homeland to minister to a tiny Catholic flock in the bustling city of Zaporozhye, Ukraine. Invoking the intercession of Our Lady of Fatima, he began construction of the Church of God the Merciful Father, inaugurated in 2004. On December 8, 2010 he was ordained a Bishop and was named the Auxiliary of the Diocese of Kharkov-Zaporozhye. Bishop Sobilo has witnessed many miracles of faith and conversion rising out of the ashes of Communism in the former Soviet Union, and he has been deeply involved with the pro-life mission of Chalice of Mercy, founded by Valentyna Pavsyukova of Chippewa Falls, WI.
