FAITH

At Queen of the Apostles, our theology campus ministry program, help students grow in their journeys toward a wholesome and holy life. Campus ministry includes school Masses, regular opportunities for reconciliation, Eucharistic adoration, *Kairos* retreats for upperclassman, *Tenui* retreats for underclassman, in-school retreats, an annual Hunger Week, national and international mission trips, parish vocation days, and more. In addition to these opportunities, each student is required to complete 15 hours per year of Christian service.

ACADEMICS

At Queen of the Apostles, we offer a rigorous curriculum with high expectations for our students. We strive to provide programs that enable all of our students to succeed, including Advanced Placement and college dual enrollment opportunities. All students in grades xx are required to read 24 books and pass a test on each one in order to receive a diploma. Our library features over 10,000 books, a complete computer lab with Apple computers and iPads, and career and college resources. We also offer one of the first high school Human Performance Labs in the Midwest to enhance our curriculum related to Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM).

ENRICHMENT

Because our goal is to develop the whole person, we encourage our students to be involved in activities to help them develop their talents and interests while learning valuable life lessons such as service, teamwork and sportsmanship.
