Period of the Precatechumenate

Participants who have not received the Sacrament of Baptism will need to receive teachings on Faith and Baptism before going through the Rite of Acceptance as they will answer questions in that regard. The prayers speak of learning to know Christ and follow Him, therefore, they are to be guided to begin to develop a daily habit of prayer and understand how to live the Catholic Moral Life. Candidates, those who have already been validly baptized, will need to receive teachings on the Sacraments of Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist as they will ask to be accepted for catechetical instruction leading to Confirmation and the Holy Eucharist at the Rite of Welcoming. We teach to the Rites and from the Rites.
