#### **Rite of Election Retreat, February 10**

In preparation for the Rite of Election and of the Call to Continuing Conversion (February 18), many parishes (or groups of parishes) offer retreats for their catechumens and candidates. For those parishes that do not offer a retreat in the parish, there will be a retreat open to catechumens and candidates on Saturday, February 10, at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. Registration begins at 9:00, and the day will conclude at 2:30. The contents will include three spiritual talks on: 1) the meaning of Lent as a time of preparation for participating in the Paschal Mystery, 2) the meaning of the Apostolic Church and the Church today (in light of their meeting Bishop Callahan, a successor to the apostles), and 3) participating in the Rite of Election, focusing on the questions and prayers it contains; time for private prayer and reflection; Mass and group prayer. #### **Rite of Election, February 18**

The Rite of Election and the Call to Continuing Conversion will be held at the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman on Sunday, February 18, at 2:00. It is an occasion that marks entry into the period of Purification and Enlightenment (for newly-named "elect") that coincides with Lent. It is a wonderful opportunity for candidates and catechumens to see the larger Church, meet Bishop Callahan, be introduced to their new Cathedral, and receive the grace of the Rite. #### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. #### **Diocesan Annual Appeal - Update**

We continue to outpace last year's Annual Appeal; we have received \$5.2 million in pledges and received gifts so far this year versus \$5 million for the same period last year. Some other highlights are: 630 first time donors giving \$87,000, and 1,364 donors who have re-engaged after not participating in the past several years giving more than \$183,000.

With the addition of the in-house scanning software and gift processing, we are processing all gifts the same day we receive them. Last year at this time, the processing was taking us 12 days from gift posting to reporting.

#### Rebates

The first parish rebates of this year's Annual Appeal will be arriving next week in parishes. Thirty-six parishes will receive a check this month. These 36 parishes have generated rebates of \$264,391.99. Even more exciting, there are a couple dozen more parishes within striking distance of their goal.

#### **Tax Statements**

2017 Tax Statements will be going to the printers at the end of this week. This will give us plenty of time to meet the January 31, 2018, mailing deadline. We expect that the Tax Statements will be in homes before the January 31 date.

#### Reminders

January reminders will be going to the printers on Wednesday, January 10<sup>th</sup> with a mail drop of January 15<sup>th</sup>. We are aware that the post office is not delivering or delaying delivery of nonprofit mail. We have been able to track mail pieces to the bin that was transported to the Post Office, and for some reason, the mail is delayed for several days or is not being delivered at all. If your parishioners are saying they are not receiving their mail, please let us know so we can document our case.
