DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.diolc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Go to the Safe Environment website to print the most current <u>forms</u>. The basic background check form was updated on July 1, 2018. If you need fingerprint cards or if you are unable to print from the website, please contact Teresa Brown at 608-791-2679. All forms, posters, pamphlets or books can be mailed to your parish or school as needed.

The <u>Safe Environment Page</u> on the Diocese of La Crosse's website has been updated. To use the <u>online training</u>, click on Program Training and pick your ministry group. Then click Complete the Safe Environment Training to go to the online training link.

All Safe Environment forms are now located in one spot- in the Library under <u>Safe</u> Environment Forms.

The age requirement has changed on Basic Background checks beginning July 1, 2018. Anyone age **16** or older who works or volunteers at a School or Parish must be background checked. This is a change; the previous age requirement was **14**.

Roe v. Wade on the Brink? - Gospel of Life Presentation by Ben Nguyen

On Tuesday, Oct. 23, at 7 p.m., Ben Nguyen will keynote the annual <u>Gospel of Life</u> <u>Celebration</u> at Blessed Sacrament Parish Hall in La Crosse. Ben, past Chancellor of the Diocese of La Crosse, will explain what we should know about the 1973 *Roe v. Wade* ruling that has been so much in the news with the Brett Kavanaugh confirmation. Ben will answer questions like: How was *Roe v. Wade* decided? How does it square with the Constitution? Is it likely to be overturned? Ben is both a civil and canon lawyer and serves as Chancellor and Canonical Counsel for the Diocese of Corpus Christi. Bishop William Patrick Callahan will celebrate Mass at 6 p.m. at Blessed Sacrament Church preceding the talk.
