DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Diocesan Annual Appeal – Stewards of Hope

We are still working with GivingTrend to get the reporting site back online. Some of the changes are available but still incomplete, and we have not verified and reconciled the data. **Please refer to the <u>Appeal Portal</u> for continuing progress updates.**

Some Highlights Year to Date: (As of 11/07/2017)

- We have 4 parishes exceeding goal, with another 5 at 80% or better.
- New Donors: 343 new donors have given \$49,149.
- SYBUNT Donors (people who gave to the appeal in the past but did not give to last year's appeal), we have 585 donors who have re-engaged in giving.
- We are up \$133,385 over last year and have raised 56% of our goal.
- For the same period last year, the number of donors participating is up by 494

The LYBUNT follow-up mailing for October launch parishes is scheduled for the end of November. A LYBUNT donor is a donor who gave last year but has not yet given this year. We also mailed a first letter to every parishioner new to our database this fall.

Essential elements for the success of the Diocesan Annual Appeal are supportive clergy, an engaged appeal committee, and knowledgeable parish staff. Thank you for continually communicating the value and progress of the appeal at your parish.
