DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Diocesan Annual Appeal

We continue to be ahead of last year for the same period. Thank you for all your efforts. New donors comprise 4% of all donors. These are our people in the pew who could be newly registered or have just not been engaged in giving to the appeal previously. We also have 8% of our donors who have re-engaged in providing to the Annual Appeal. These donors have given to the appeal in the past but did not participate last year. Both of these sets of donors are indicators of active growth numbers at a time when most diocesan appeals are declining and or struggling to meet their goal. These new and re-engaged numbers are a credit to your efforts.
