Rite of Election Retreat, March 2

In preparation for the Rite of Election and of the Call to Continuing Conversion (March 10), many parishes (or groups of parishes) offer retreats for their catechumens and candidates. For those parishes that do not offer a retreat in the parish, there will be three retreats open to catechumens and candidates on the morning of Saturday, March 2: at St. Peter Parish in Stevens Point, St. Mary Parish in Altoona, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. Although schedules may vary slightly at each retreat site, the day will include Mass, three spiritual talks, time for reflection, and lunch. A site-specific schedule will be sent upon

registration or upon request. Registration form is available here; deadline is February 22. Please encourage those in your RCIA process to reserve this date.

Rite of Election, March 10

The Rite of Election and the Call to Continuing Conversion will be held at the Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman on Sunday, March 10, at 2:00. It is an occasion that marks entry into the period of Purification and Enlightenment (for newly-named "elect") that coincides with Lent. It is a wonderful opportunity for candidates and catechumens to see the larger Church, meet Bishop Callahan, be introduced to their new Cathedral, and receive the grace of the Rite. Diocesan Annual Appeal – Endurance in Hope

The Church continues to work to fulfill its mission. The Diocesan Annual Appeal is how we as a diocesan community fund our commitment to do our part of fulfilling the mission. The good works continue as our story is told through the appeal, connecting with those who want to invest in the many good works. Thank you to all parish leaders who continue to promote this vital ministry. Remember to keep developing this ministry, as it is the largest source of funding for our charitable works and ministries.

As of February 18, 2019:

- We are at 91% of our goal and \$133,333 ahead of last year at this time
- 39 Parishes have received more than a quarter million dollars in rebates this year so far
- 91 Parishes have raised more money this year than last year at this time
- 376 new investors to the Annual Appeal. These are people who have never invested in the Diocesan Annual Appeal before
- 951 investors who were lapsed for at least one year are now re-engaged
- 6,115 investors have invested more this year than last year at this time
- The average pledge is \$456, compared to \$417 last year

We are preparing for our next mailing, which is scheduled to be in mailboxes before Palm Sunday weekend. We will be targeting all LYBUNTS and new parish members from all parishes. We will also be mailing to any SYBUNT and "Nevers" of any parish under goal.
