DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Property Tax Exemption

Property Tax Exemption reports are due to your city, township, or village every two years on even numbered years. Many parishes may have already received these forms. If you have not received a form you will need to contact the Clerk of your city, township, or village to get one completed. These forms need to be completed or the parish will be become taxable property and will need to pay taxes. The forms are due by March 31.
