REMINDER: Mission Coop Program (MCP) Summer 2018: The assignments for parishes and mission dioceses and religious orders are now completed. The information should be in the hands of both the parish pastors and the coordinating missionaries. Please take time to read the complete information, especially the instructions regarding the collection and handling of MCP funds. Here are a few notes regarding frequently asked questions:

- Please schedule the Mission Coop weekend as soon as possible. This is especially important where there are anticipated assignment changes. You will help the arriving pastor by scheduling now and making sure that staff is informed and prepared. Waiting until the new pastor arrives makes it more difficult for everyone involved.
- If it is necessary to schedule a Mission Coop appeal outside of the normally expected summer months, it may NOT be scheduled on WORLD MISSION SUNDAY (Oct. 20-21, 2018). All proceeds collected on World Mission Sunday are sent to the Pontifical Mission Societies and shared with over 1,100 mission areas around the world.
- 3. No Mission Coop Program appeals should be scheduled on weekends which would interfere with the Diocesan Annual Appeal kick offs in the fall.

If there are any further questions regarding the Mission Coop Program, please contact the Mission Office. We appreciate all the work that our parishes do so that God's kingdom may be made stronger through the missionaries you generously welcome and support.

Spring Confirmation(s) season is upon us! Pastors of parishes hosting Confirmations are kindly asked to watch their email inbox for detailed information. Please remember to complete all forms in full and return them no later than <u>one week</u> before the anticipated date of the ceremony. Any questions in regards to the liturgical celebration can be directed to the Diocesan Office of Pontifical Ceremonies. A parish that is only <u>hosting</u> a Confirmation liturgy (*with no candidates of their own*) are to request one of the participating parishes to be the principal contact for that Confirmation liturgy. That parish should provide all requested information to the Diocesan Office for Pontifical Ceremonies. Questions about the Confirmation schedule should be directed to Debbie Brannon in the Office of the Diocesan Bishop – <u>dbrannon@diolc.org</u>.

Ceremonial Updates to Confirmation: Please be sure to read <u>all</u> the information sent in regards to the *Rite of Confirmation Liturgy* - most importantly the *Emcee Letter* and the *Ceremonial Guidelines for the Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation*. Both of these documents include new and updated information that will help make your Confirmation Liturgy go smoothly and with proper solemnity. One new guideline pertains to the reception of the gifts during the Offertory.

150th Banner at Pontifical Liturgies: During the Sesquicentennial Year, parishes that will be hosting Bishop Callahan are asked to display in their sanctuary, or other proper area if the celebration is outside of Holy Mass, the Diocesan 150th banner or tri-fold display board. If your parish does not have one, please contact the Diocesan Office of Pontifical Ceremonies

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
