Decree Promulgating Norms for the Compensation of the Clergy. Having received a positive recommendation from the Presbyteral Council at its April 19, 2018 meeting, I have attached the new <u>Decree</u> Promulgating Norms for the Compensation of the Clergy in the Diocese of La Crosse, as well as the updated Priests' Salary Schedule, a sample Mileage Log and a Works of Charity Disbursements Log (these forms will be available for you on the Office of Temporalities webpage at <u>http://diolc.org/temporalities/</u>). Changes were made to have a standard 2% increase each year, which will be in effect until changed. A new schedule will come out every year. The Social Security Reimbursement has been added to the base pay so

no separate reimbursement for Social Security will be paid. The options for board based on housekeepers have been removed and a standard amount of \$400 taken as an allowance or as a reimbursement of receipts are the two options. Please see the requirement for this reimbursement to be non-taxable. The Help-out rate has been increased to \$40 per Mass for weekends and Holy Days of Obligation and \$25 per Mass for weekdays. There are other changes as well so please read the document carefully and apply beginning July 1, 2018. This *Decree* is to replace the current *Norms* in the Parish Administration Manual under the Section "Admin.III.page 1-4."



REMINDER - Spring Confirmation season is upon us! Pastors of parishes hosting Confirmations are kindly asked to watch their email inbox for detailed information. Please remember to complete all forms in full and return them no later than <u>one week</u> before the anticipated date of the ceremony. Any questions in regards to the liturgical celebration can be directed to the Diocesan Office of Pontifical Ceremonies. A parish that is only <u>hosting</u> a Confirmation liturgy (*with no candidates of their own*) are to request one of the participating parishes to be the principal contact for that Confirmation liturgy. That parish is to provide all requested information to the Diocesan Office for Pontifical Ceremonies. REMINDER - Ceremonial Updates to Confirmation: Please be sure to read <u>all</u> the information sent in regards to the *Rite of Confirmation Liturgy* - most importantly the *Emcee Letter* and the *Ceremonial Guidelines for the Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation*. Both of these documents include new and updated information that will help make your Confirmation Liturgy go smoothly and with proper solemnity. One new guideline pertains to the reception of the gifts during the Offertory.

Misal Romano Workshops 2018

On September 14, 2017, Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston and President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), announced a publication date for the long-awaited *Misal Romano, tercera edición*—the Spanish translation of the third edition of the Roman Missal for use in the United States. The revised text may be used in the liturgy as soon as Pentecost 2018 and its use becomes mandatory of the First Sunday of Advent 2018.

The publication of the *Misal Romano* marks the first time that the United States has its own Spanish-language edition of the Roman Missal. Members of the FDLC, in collaboration with the secretariat staff of the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship, will offer a series of oneday workshops in preparation for the new *Misal*. Those closest locations to La Crosse include the May 22 workshop in Northbrook, IL, and the September 4 workshop in New Brighton, MN. Full details and registration are available <u>here</u>.

Liturgical Calendar

<u>May 1</u> (Tuesday): Saint Joseph the Worker, principal patron of the Diocese. The proper Mass for this solemnity, with its proper orations & readings, the *Gloria*, Creed, & the Preface of St. Joseph, is to be celebrated throughout the Diocese on this day. In the Liturgy of the Hours, the *Te Deum* is said in the Office of Readings. Proper psalms and readings are taken, where lacking, from the Office for the Solemnity of St. Joseph, Husband of Mary, on March 19. <u>May 7</u> (Monday): Feast of the Anniversary of the Dedication of the Cathedral, observed throughout the Diocese outside of the Cathedral as a feast (See General Norms for the Liturgical Year and Calendar, Table of Liturgical Days, II.8.b). The orations and readings for the Mass are taken from the Common of the Dedication of a Church. The *Gloria* is recited and the *Te Deum* is said in the Office of Readings. White vestments are worn. <u>May 13</u> (Sunday): Solemnity of the Ascension. Transferred to the Seventh Sunday of Easter, Sunday, May 13, using the liturgical texts proper to the Ascension; Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter (May 10) is celebrated as an Easter weekday or an option memorial for St. Damien de Veuster.
