Diocesan Assessment Reports – Schools

The 5th, 8th, and 11th grade Catholic School reports for students who took the <u>Faith</u> <u>Knowledge Assessments</u> and <u>Attitudes and Practices Surveys</u> were mailed to the administrators on May 11th. These reports provide valuable information that can serve as a baseline for the school to see how well students are learning the teachings of the Church and the extent to which students are being evangelized in the Faith. The reports are <u>not</u> about grading or evaluating each student. Rather, analysis of the assessment results should help teachers make important decisions regarding what is taught and how young people should be formed in the Faith. It is likely that schools would be unaware of some, or even all of these shortcomings without the assessments. Given the challenges of our culture, poorly prepared Catholics will have far greater struggles maintaining their relationship with Christ and the corresponding practices of the Catholic Faith.

Employment Contracts for Catechetical Leaders

If you would like to receive an Employment Contract for the parish DRE, CRE and/or Youth Minister, please contact Ann. It is suggested that contracts only be offered to fulltime Catechetical Leaders who work 30 hours or more, which was the original reason that contracts were established. Further, keep in mind that contracts are not an absolute necessity. All persons who work at the Diocesan Offices are at-will employees.

Reminder: World Mission Sunday (Oct. 21, 2018) Envelope Order: Please notify the Mission Office (<u>mapel@diolc.org</u> or 608-791-2676) **by May 23** if your World Mission Sunday poster and envelope order (which is shipped directly from the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in New York) needs to be changed in any way. The Mission Office is privileged to forward Mass intentions and accompanying stipends to missionary dioceses and religious orders. By your generosity, prayer intentions are met in a timely manner and Bishops and Religious Superiors are able to offer a supplemented income to rural parish priests where collections do not suffice in supporting parish expenses. Memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church, May 21

On February 11, 2018, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments inscribed a new obligatory Memorial of "Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church," into the General Roman Calendar. This memorial will be celebrated every year on the Monday after Pentecost.

A full Mass formulary—including Collect, Prayer over the Offerings, Preface, Prayer after Communion, and Entrance and Communion Antiphons—is already included within the *Roman Missal* in the section of Votive Masses: 10. Blessed Virgin Mary, B. Our Lady, Mother of the Church.

A set of proper (i.e., mandatory) readings has been assigned for this new memorial. Since the precise verses and acclamation are not found together in any one place in the Lectionary for Mass, the USCCB Secretariat of Divine Worship has prepared a PDF resource of the readings to facilitate their use, <u>here</u>. White vestments are worn.

An English version of the proper texts for the Memorial of the "Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church" will be included in the Liturgy of the Hours, Second Edition, after translation by the International Commission on English in the Liturgy, approval by the USCCB, and confirmation by the Holy See.

Misal Romano Workshops 2018

On September 14, 2017, Cardinal Daniel N. DiNardo, Archbishop of Galveston-Houston and President of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), announced a publication date for the long-awaited *Misal Romano, tercera edición*—the Spanish translation of the third edition of the Roman Missal for use in the United States. The revised text may be used in the liturgy as soon as Pentecost 2018 and its use becomes mandatory of the First Sunday of Advent 2018.

The publication of the *Misal Romano* marks the first time that the United States has its own Spanish-language edition of the Roman Missal. Members of the FDLC, in collaboration with the secretariat staff of the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship, will offer a series of oneday workshops in preparation for the new *Misal*. Those closest locations to La Crosse include the May 22 workshop in Northbrook, IL, and the September 4 workshop in New Brighton, MN. Full details and registration are available <u>here</u>.

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.diolc.org .
