Reminder: World Mission Sunday (Oct. 21, 2018) Envelope Order: Please notify the Mission Office (<u>mapel@diolc.org</u> or 608-791-2676) **by May 23** if your World Mission Sunday poster and envelope order (which is shipped directly from the Society for the Propagation of the Faith in New York) needs to be changed in any way. Envelopes can be ordered in the following quantities: 0, 100, 250, 500, 1,000, 1,500, 2,000 +. Some parishes receive WMS envelopes in their Sunday/Holy Day envelope packets, but a small extra quantity may be helpful for visitors. A <u>Letter of Suitability</u> with the specific verbiage for the Diocese of La Crosse is required (**before** the appeal is given) for any priest not currently serving in our Diocese. Reminder: Mass Stipend requests: We are in need of Mass Stipends to replenish our depleted account. The Mission Office is privileged to forward Mass intentions and accompanying stipends to missionary dioceses and religious orders. By your generosity, prayer intentions are met in a timely manner and Bishops and Religious Superiors are able to offer a supplemented income to rural parish priests where collections do not suffice in supporting parish expenses. We have also been able to supply a few priests of the diocese not assigned to parishes with a smaller number of Masses. DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. Diocese of La Crosse Group Health and Dental Plan Open Enrollment

- Open enrollment is a period of time each year when employees have the option to enroll or make changes to options in the Group Health and Dental Plans offered by the Diocese.
- Open Enrollment for the coverage period of 2018 2109 will be changed to the month of May beginning this year, instead of the month of August.
- Open Enrollment will be from May 23, 2018 through end of day June 15, 2018 information will be sent via email communication on Wednesday, May 23, 2018.
- Elections made during open enrollment will become effective July 1, 2018 with the coverage year being July 1 through June 30.
- The deductibles will continue to apply to each Participant on a per Calendar Year basis, January 1 through December 31.
