Email and Text message scams continue

There have been many reports of fraudulent email and text messages being sent "from the pastor" or other parish staff or clergy member asking for iTune Gift Card purchases or other donations or money transfers. Please get the word out about these scams.

If you believe you're the victim of a scam involving App Store & iTunes Gift Cards or Apple Store Gift Cards, you can call Apple at 800-275-2273 (U.S.) and say "gift cards" when prompted. From what we are seeing, lists (available on the public internet) containing e-mail addresses and cell phone numbers are being used to make the relationship between a pastor and his parishioner or parish staff member. Please be careful not to publish e-mail addresses or cell phone numbers publicly (typically on a website or in your parish bulletin that gets posted to your parish website). Care must be taken to protect our e-mail addresses and the relationships they have to parish staff.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608.519.8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. A huge well done to the Richland Center Deanery for being the 1st Deanery to send in all of their 2018-19 Safe Environment Reports. All their data has been entered and Richland Center is 100% complete for this reporting year. The La Crosse Deanery was #2 with turning in their reports, but has 2 Parishes that need to make corrections and Tomah Deanery is #3. Their last report was received on 5-24-19 but needs a few updates before it is complete.

How does your Deanery look?

Arcadia – 2 reports needed, 1 parish that needs corrections Chippewa – 5 reports needed Durand – 4 reports needed Eau Claire – 1 report needed and 1 parish report that needs corrections La Crosse – All reports in, 2 parishes that need corrections Marshfield – 2 reports needed Prairie du Chien – 1 report needed Stevens Point – 4 reports needed, 1 parish that needs corrections Thorp – 2 reports needed Tomah – All reports in, 1 parish that needs corrections Wausau- 4 reports needed, 2 parishes that need corrections Wisconsin Rapids – 3 reports needed

Reminder: When you send in print cards, an FBI release form must also come with the prints. It is form # 4 on the <u>Diocesan Website under Safe Environment</u>.
