

Memorial of Mary, Mother of the Church, May 21

On February 11, 2018, the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments inscribed a new obligatory Memorial of "Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church," into the General Roman Calendar. This memorial will be celebrated every year on the Monday after Pentecost.

A full Mass formulary—including Collect, Prayer over the Offerings, Preface, Prayer after Communion, and Entrance and Communion Antiphons—is already included within the *Roman Missal* in the section of Votive Masses: 10. Blessed Virgin Mary, B. Our Lady, Mother of the Church.

A set of proper (i.e., mandatory) readings has been assigned for this new memorial. Since the precise verses and acclamation are not found together in any one place in the Lectionary for

Mass, the USCCB Secretariat of Divine Worship has prepared a PDF resource of the readings to facilitate their use, here. White vestments are worn.

An English version of the proper texts for the Memorial of the "Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church" will be included in the Liturgy of the Hours, Second Edition, after translation by the International Commission on English in the Liturgy, approval by the USCCB, and confirmation by the Holy See.

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: www.diolc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. US Bishops Urge Legislative Support for Religious Freedom

- The First Amendment Defense Act (S. 2525) would bar the federal government from discriminating against individuals and organizations based upon their religious beliefs or moral convictions that marriage is the union of one man and one woman.
- The Child Welfare Provider Inclusion Act (CWPIA) protects the religious liberties of child welfare service providers regarding the placement of children, including adoption and foster care agencies.

Diocese of La Crosse Group Health and Dental Plan Open Enrollment

Open enrollment is a period of time each year when employees have the option to enroll or make changes to options in the Group Health and Dental Plans offered by the Diocese.

In working to add efficiencies and improve the dissemination of information to employees while also aligning both Diocesan Health Plans (Lay Group and Priests Group) Open Enrollment for the coverage period of 2018 – 2109 will be changed to the month of May beginning this year, instead of the month of August.

Elections made during open enrollment will become effective July 1, 2018 with the coverage year being July 1 through June 30. Open enrollment information will be sent out during the week of May 14th. The open enrollment period will be for a period of at least 2 weeks.

The deductibles will continue to apply to each Participant on a per Calendar Year basis, January 1 through December 31.
