Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608.519.8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. Diocesan Annual Appeal – Endurance in Hope

The Church continues to work to fulfill its mission. The Diocesan Annual Appeal is how we, as a diocesan community, fund our commitment to do our part of fulfilling the mission. The good works continue as our story is told through the appeal, connecting with those who want to invest in the many good works. Thank you to all parish leaders who continue to promote this vital ministry. Remember to keep developing this ministry, as it is the largest source of funding for our charitable works and ministries.

As of June 10, 2019:

- We have raised \$5,816,986
- 82 Parishes are receiving more than \$640,000 in rebates so far this year
- 73 Parishes have raised \$326,275 more money this year than last year at this time
- 510 new investors to the Annual Appeal so far this year; these people have never invested in the Diocesan Annual Appeal before and represent 1.3% of funding received or \$76,670
- 1,286 investors who were lapsed for at least one year are now re-engaged for \$181,261 or 3.1% of funds received
- 17,936 (80%) of our supporters from last year have reinvested this year
- 6,645 investors have invested more this year than last year at this time; the average increase is \$174
- The average pledge is \$450, compared to \$417 last year
- 55 new people are investing through recurring installments. These people give monthly all year round. People using recurring installments tend to invest more on average than their one-time gift counterparts; best of all, their summer activity can provide you with momentum when starting next year's appeal.

- Parishes who have a Stewardship Committee and went over their goal averaged 8.4% more above their goal than parishes who do not have a Stewardship Committee but still exceeded their goal.
- Parishes that have exceeded their goal and who do have a Stewardship Committee raised 42% on average more than parishes who did not have a Stewardship Committee and still have not yet exceeded their goal. Contact our office if you would like to become a Stewardship Parish!

The last Diocesan Annual Appeal mailing for the appeal year was sent to all LYBUNTS for all parishes, and SYBUNT and Never Givers for those parishes who were below target. The video messaging is "Labor of Love," available on our website, promoted on Facebook, which examines the good works of Catholic Charities, please share the videos freely.

Mutual of America has provided the following information for 403B retirement participants.

A small increase can go a long way

Perhaps you've been considering increasing the amount you contribute through payroll deduction to your retirement savings plan, but believe that a small increase per pay period would be of minimal effect. This may be true if you expect to retire and draw upon these funds in only a few years, but if retirement is still many years away, you should reconsider.

The tables below display the impacts that even small increases in regular contributions may have. The first table shows the growth of \$5 contributions made twice a month over periods of 10, 20, 30 and 40 years, assuming various growth rates (3%, 5% and 7%). For example, \$5 contributions made regularly for 10 years can grow to \$1,397 if the account experiences a 3% growth rate. If the account grows at a 5% rate, the contributions grow to \$1,548. If this scenario continues for 40 years, the account grows to \$9,189 at 3% and \$14,871 at 5%. We then repeat the process for \$10 and \$20 contributions.
