Liturgical Observance of Blessed Solanus Casey, July 30

The feast day of Blessed Solanus Casey is July 30. The General Instruction of the Roman Missal permits a votive Mass in his honor to be said this year: "On weekdays in Ordinary Time, there may be chosen either the Mass of the weekday, or the Mass of an Optional Memorial which happens to occur on that day, or the Mass of any Saint inscribed in the Martyrology for that day..." (n.355c). If such a Mass is said, the orations can be taken from either the "Common of Pastors" of the "Common of Holy Men, for Religious." Readings may

be taken from Monday of the 17th Week in Ordinary Time or from the same Common sections in the Lectionary.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. In order to see for themselves what was happening to newly arrived immigrants, families and children, Cardinal Daniel DiNardo, president of the U.S. Bishops Conference, and five other bishops conducted a pastoral visit to the diocese of Brownsville, Texas on July 1 and 2. Stops included Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of San Juan del Valle with the community, a visit to

an HHS/OBR Shelter and Mass for the families there, a visit to the Customs and Border Patrol processing center in McAllen, TX, and a press conference at the end of their visit.
