#### **Standard Operating Procedures for Offertory Plate Contributions**

We have 70 parishes leading the way in best practice offertory plate contributions accountability and transparency using ParishSOFT. Thank you for your leadership! We continue to ask that all parishes use the generic family named "Loose Cash", ID# 63626, to record weekly anonymous and cash plate contributions. This best practice promotes continuous improvement and establishes a clear audit trail. Details for implementing this important standard can be found on <a href="mailto:diolc.org/pims">diolc.org/pims</a> in the <a href="mailto:ParishSOFT Standard Operating Procedure">ParishSOFT Standard Operating Procedure</a> (SOP) document. Reference the SOP table of contents for Loose Cash, using Ctrl+Click to navigate to that section of the SOP.

This Loose Cash generic entity is intended for use diocesan-wide at every parish. Administrative staff should share it as an unregistered family in the Contributor Only family group. When sharing this entity into your parish *please do not change its generic address, phone, email, or other field values.* All parishes need to share this same family record. After sharing this family record to your parish please notify Margot Lorraine, (608) 791 2695. She will merge your previous, parish-specific, loose cash entity into the preferred Loose Cash ID# 63626 entity. Her merge will enable your parish to maintain a continuous and consistent record of previous cash contributions. It will also remove your previous, parish-specific record from the database to avoid future data conflicts. Begin this new fiscal year by adopting this offertory plate contribution best practice. #### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <a href="mailto:kbecker@cclse.org">kbecker@cclse.org</a>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <a href="mailto:www.diolc.org">www.diolc.org</a>. #### Deadline tomorrow - July 31: Show Your Support for the Protect Life Rule

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has proposed the Protect Life Rule, stopping Title X Family Planning tax dollars from going to organizations that perform or promote abortions. This would effectively defund Planned Parenthood of as much as \$60 million of our tax dollars each year. Before the rule can go into effect, there has to be a public comment period. #### **Asbestos Re-Inspections**

School asbestos re-inspections will be occurring in the 2018-2019 school year. These are regulated inspections that occur every 3 years. The Office of Diocesan Building and Grounds will be working with our asbestos consultant to schedule these inspections. Anticipated start date will be later in the fall.

Please note, if your parish or school has any regularly scheduled daycare, pre-school, early childhood education, or charter school that is not currently inspected, you are required to have these facilities inspected every 3 years. Please contact Kathy Haverland in the Office for Diocesan Buildings and Grounds to get these facilities on the asbestos schedule. All schools are required to have a designated person in charge of asbestos management, locations, and routine surveillance of asbestos. If you have any concerns or questions regarding this requirement, please contact the Office for Diocesan Buildings and Grounds.
