Going Deeper in Prayer

This prayer initiative is in response to requests by catechetical leaders, schoolteachers, priests and most notably high school students. The vision is to teach the age-level prayers as in the past, but to have a focus on one prayer throughout the year in each grade so that students can encounter Christ and develop a deeper relationship with Him. Feedback on the materials was gathered this past year from school and parish personnel. Resources will be distributed in the deaneries. Parents are to be given these resources first as they are the primary educators of their children. The results from the assessments have shown that family prayer needs to be strengthened in partnership with schools and Faith formation program

RCIA Calendar of Teachings and Liturgies

Have you Considered the 15-month RCIA Process?

The RCIA is a process of conversion that is meant to form and prepare adults to become committed disciples of Jesus Christ and courageous witnesses to the Catholic Faith. At the heart of the RCIA process is the time candidates need to develop and deepen their relationship with Christ through a daily habit of prayer, to experience conversion through understanding the basic teachings of the Church, and to commit to actively participating in Sunday Mass. This process takes a minimum of 15 months to develop. After experiencing both the 9-month and 15-month processes, there is really no comparison. Even small, rural parishes are seeing fruits from the 15-month process. <u>Here's why</u>.

Mass Schedule for Immaculate Conception, December 8

The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception this year is Saturday, December 8, and it remains a holyday of obligation. Masses on Friday evening, December 7, and during the day of Saturday, December 8, will observe the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. Masses beginning the evening of Saturday, December 8 will observe the Second Sunday of Advent. Catholics are to attend Mass twice that weekend, once to fulfill the holyday of obligation (Immaculate Conception) and once to satisfy the Sunday obligation.

Liturgical Calendar Dates

September 26 (Wednesday): Rural Life Day, day of thanksgiving for blessings received. Prayer texts from *The Mass for Various Needs and Occasions: After the Harvest* (n.28) can be used with Preface V of the Sundays in Ordinary Time. The readings may be taken from *After the Harvest* in the Lectionary (n.20), numbers 917-921. The *Gloria* also ought to be said.

October 7 (Sunday): Diocesan Sesquicentennial closing Mass, 10:30, Cathedral of St. Joseph the Workman.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>.
