Parish Religion Assessments cancelled in order to focus on Prayer

In the <u>Parish Programs</u>, the Religion Assessments will be cancelled another year in order to focus on "Going Deeper in Prayer." (Schools will continue to take the assessments this year.) This prayer initiative is in response to requests by catechetical leaders, schoolteachers, priests and most notably high school students. The vision is to teach the age-level prayers as in the past, but to have a focus on one prayer throughout the year in each grade so that students can encounter Christ and develop a deeper relationship with Him. Feedback was gathered this past year from school and parish personnel. Final feedback will be gathered from participants at the August Conference and then the resources will be distributed in the deaneries. Parents are to be given these resources <u>first</u> as they are the primary educators of their children. The results from the assessments have shown that family prayer needs to be strengthened in partnership with schools and Faith formation programs.



DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (employee, volunteers, vendors, religious or clergy). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608-519-8002 or <u>kbecker@cclse.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of the Vicar for Clergy or on the diocesan website at: <u>www.diolc.org</u>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. Bishops Call for a Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life

The U.S. Bishops urge our participation in a nationwide Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life, each Friday from August 3 through September 28. Cardinal Timothy Dolan, Chairman of the USCCB Committee on Pro-Life Activities, invited all people of good will to join in this campaign of prayer that the change in the U.S. Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life. In addition to the current invitation to fast on Fridays, participants will be encouraged to pray one *Our Father, Hail Mary*, and *Glory Be* for this intention and will receive important facts about how *Roe v*. *Wade* is not health care, is bad law, and fails women.
