Standard Operating Procedures for Offertory Plate Contributions

We have 27 parishes leading the way in best practice offertory plate contributions accountability and transparency using ParishSOFT. Thank you for your leadership! We continue to ask that all parishes use the generic family named "Loose Cash", ID# 63626, to record weekly anonymous and cash plate contributions. This best practice promotes continuous improvement and establishes a clear audit trail. Details for implementing this important standard can be found on diolc.org/pims in the ParishSOFT Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) document. Reference the SOP table of contents for Loose Cash, using Ctrl+Click to navigate to that section of the SOP.

This Loose Cash generic entity is intended for use diocesan-wide at every parish. Administrative staff should share it as an unregistered family in the Contributor Only family group. When sharing this entity into your parish *please do not change its generic address, phone, email, or other field values*. All parishes need to share this same family record. After sharing this family record to your parish please notify Margot Lorraine, (608) 791 2695. She will merge your previous, parish-specific, loose cash entity into the preferred Loose Cash ID# 63626 entity. Her merge will enable your parish to maintain a continuous and consistent record of previous cash contributions. It will also remove your previous, parish-specific record from the database to avoid future data conflicts.

Begin this new fiscal year by adopting this offertory plate contribution best practice. Thank you for your help consolidating and improving our reporting.

Standard Operating Procedures for Offertory Plate Contributions

Finance staff please see the notice regarding adoption of the diocesan-wide generic family "Loose Cash", ID# 63626, in the Communication section of this bulletin. The document is found in the ParishSOFT Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) document.

Updates from St. Ambrose Financial Services

The interest rates have changed effective July 2, 2018, increasing by 20 basis points.

- Deposits will now earn 1.95%
- Loans will accrue interest at 2.70%
- Lines of Credit will accrue interest at 4.70%.

Reminder: 403(b) Thrift Plan Revisions

There are some beneficial modifications to the Plan that are reflected in the **403(b) Thrift Plan Highlight Sheet** located on http://stambrosefinancial.com/. Changes include the following:

1. Eligibility for Employer Contributions

- Effective July 1, 2018 Immediate eligibility for those scheduled to work at least 20 hours a week during the school year. Seasonal employees are not eligible for employer base contributions (please contact Marie Gernes, Diocesan Finance Officer at 608.791.2668 or mgernes@diolc.org with any questions on this seasonal classification).
- Note that there may be employees who are now eligible as of July 1st for Employer Contributions. They need to enroll in the plan for the 1% base contribution.

2. Pre-Tax or Roth Contributions

Effective July 1, 2018 - Employees can designate their personal contribution as **Pre-Tax and/or Roth** designation.

- Traditional/Pre-Tax Contribution
 - Contributions are excluded from income for the year(s) in which they are made
 - On withdrawal Contributions and earnings are taxable as income

- Designated Roth Contribution
 - After tax contributions are included in income for the year(s) in which they are made
 - On withdrawal Federal-income-tax-free as long as the five-year rule is satisfied and a participant is age 59 ½ or older, becomes disabled or dies. If these conditions are not met, earnings, but not contributions, are taxable as withdrawn.

- The Employee Enrollment Form for Thrift Plans and the 403(b) Contribution Election
 Form have also been modified to reflect the change with the Roth contribution and
 provides two options.
- 4. **Employer Submission of Contributions** have also been modified to reflect the change with the Roth contribution and provides two options:
 - a. For payroll centers that upload an Excel file add the Participant Roth contribution as <u>Column N</u> on your file template. No other changes to the file format are needed.
 - b. For payroll centers that generate a new remittance there will be new columns on the remittance to provide Participant Roth contributions
