Formation for Catechetical Leaders and Catechists

Every parish or deanery is to provide 6 hours of training for catechists. Catechetical Leaders are to receive 12 hours of formation over the year. A great new way to provide this training is through the Catechetical Institute who has developed online workshops to assist you with this training at very little cost. Each workshop provides an hour of content divided into short video clips (10 minutes) followed by a simple skills-building task. These tasks allow you to process the material by answering a simple question or implementing something into your classroom. This formation is foremost to help you deepen your Faith and spiritual life to become intentional disciples and stronger witnesses of Christ and His Church. DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (clergy, employee, religious, vendors or volunteers). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608.519.8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. If you have any questions about the Diocese of La Crosse and the implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, please contact Teresa Brown, Diocese of La Crosse, at 608.791.2679; or tbrown@diolc.org.

ParishSoft is a database that is used daily by the diocesan curia. I'm asking each parish to verify that the name of the Safe Environment Contact for their parish is in the staff listing of ParishSoft and assigned the Safe Environment Contact position. Even if the DRE/CRE or Parish Secretary does the Safe Environment work, they should have the Safe Environment Contact position label behind their name. A person can be assigned multiple positions within their Parish. I will be sending out many important and informational emails in the next few weeks to names in this database, and I'd like to ensure that every parish contact receives the information.

James Miller was born into a family of farmers near Stevens Point on September 21, 1944, attended Pacelli High School, and joined the De La Salle Christian Brothers in 1959. He served as a missionary in Nicaragua and then Guatemala, where he was shot and killed by 3 hooded men on Feb. 13, 1982, during Guatemala's civil war. Pope Francis decreed that he died a martyr for the Faith and has set his beatification for Dec. 7, 2019 in Huehuetenango, Guatemala.
