### Reminder - What is next with MyParish app? Introducing EVANGELUS

In 2015, FAITH Catholic, the publishing partner for Catholic Life, was proud to collaborate with Diocesan to make MyParish app available to all parishes of the Diocese of La Crosse for free. Now Diocesan has announced an exciting new solution for dioceses and parishes called EVANGELUS. It enables parishes to use a single new communications tool to reach parishioners through email, text, MyParish app, social media and websites. To find out more, click here.

The typical cost is \$99/month per parish. Exclusively for the Diocese of La Crosse and its parishes, the cost is \$59/month per parish. MyParish app will still be available for free when you purchase EVANGELUS. If your parish wants to continue with MyParish app without EVANGELUS, it will remain free as a stand-alone solution through 2020. After January 1, 2021, your parish can continue to use it for \$37/month.

#### Reminder - Protocols for missionary priest help-outs for your parish

This is just a reminder regarding invitations to missionary priests who may come to give pastors a weekend break. They are important and helpful options, but they need to follow diocesan protocol during their visits. The Mission Office has no connection to or official relationship with Catholic associations like Food for the Poor, Cross Catholic Outreach, Unbound Ministries or other such organizations. Their individual policies for the collection of funds should be clearly stated before their arrival and pastors should communicate the information to staff and parishioners in preparation for their appeal. As always, Safe Environment policies need to be followed. Therefore, Letters of Suitability for priests need to be on file with the Vicar for Clergy office if they are celebrating the sacraments.

**Fall Confirmation** season is upon us. Pastors/Liturgy Coordinators hosting Confirmations are reminded to complete all forms in full and return them no later than one week before the anticipated date of the ceremony. Any questions in regards to the liturgical celebration can be directed to the Diocesan Office for Pontifical Ceremonies. Questions about the Confirmation schedule should be directed to the Dean of your Deanery.

**Ceremonial Updates to Confirmation:** Please be sure to read all the information sent in regards to the *Rite of Confirmation Liturgy* - most importantly the *Emcee Letter* and the *Ceremonial Guidelines for the Celebration of the Sacrament of Confirmation*. Both documents include new and updated information that will help make your Confirmation Liturgy go smoothly and with proper solemnity. Updated guidelines are in place in regards to the seating of candidates and sponsors, photography, and the presentation of candidates.

**Letters of Suitability:** Any Confirmation Mass locations that are planning to have a priest/deacon be present from outside the Diocese of La Crosse and requests to concelebrate/assist they are to have a Letter of Suitability provided to the Office for the Vicar of Clergy prior to the date of the liturgy. They can be emailed to Paula Boyle at

<u>pboyle@diolc.org</u> with the original being sent in the mail. She, in turn, will advise the Office for Pontifical Ceremonies of the guest cleric/s so they can plan accordingly.

#### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (clergy, employee, religious, vendors or volunteers). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608.519.8002 or <a href="mailto:kbecker@cclse.org">kbecker@cclse.org</a>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <a href="mailto:diolc.org">diolc.org</a>. In the past week or so, Catholic Mutual has received a handful of notifications of incidences involving ground bee stings. Catholic Mutual has asked us to inform you that it appears to be a bumper year for ground bees, which can easily go undetected until the nest is disturbed in some manner. These bees can cause major pain and discomfort to even those who aren't allergic and can have dire consequences for those that are. Catholic Mutual recommends the parishes conduct a careful inspection of their grounds in order to identify any potential infestations and have them removed by a qualified professional, especially when discovered near schools, on playgrounds, or near church entrances or commonly used grounds.
