Information was requested about FORMED. This is a type of Catholic Netflix that includes a large amount of current programs (Bible Studies and Faith Formation etc.) movies, audios and e-Books. The subscription paid by a parish for one year allows all parishioners served by a priest to access all available resources on FORMED. The concept is excellent, that people can watch programs, movies etc. with their spouse and family in their own home. And the parish can offer these Bible Studies and Faith Formation Programs for parishioners in groups, viewing them from the internet. However, this platform works best when parishioners have already engaged in ongoing formation as adults. For parishes just getting started with Bible Studies etc., this platform might not be the best use of funds. Extraordinary Missionary Month: Pope Francis has called us to celebrate the centenary of the Apostolic Letter, *Maximum Illud*. In the year 1919, following the end of World War I, Pope Benedict XV sent his message to the Catholic Church in every nation. DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (clergy, employee, religious, vendors or volunteers). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to the Most Reverend William Patrick Callahan, Bishop of La Crosse, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Karen Becker, Victim Assistance Ministry, 608.519.8002 or kbecker@cclse.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
