Strategic Planning. As we begin a strategic planning process, we are looking for planning team members. If you would like to be part of a team or you know someone that has an

Once the teams have been selected for each of the areas (Education, Parish Life & Spirituality, Community) the members will determine the frequency and timing of the meetings for their group. Each team will complete tasks in three areas, development of the questionnaire that will be used for gathering of information, training of the parish planning teams, analysis and reporting of information received. Religious Certification

All information regarding Religious Certification for all those who hand on the Faith has been updated. <u>Click here</u> for the most current information and forms. Growing in the Catholic Faith through study and prayer is a life-long process. It is essential, above all, for any adult who teaches the Catholic Faith to receive ongoing formation in order to properly hand on the Faith to the next generation. Ongoing faith formation is necessary as "the quality of any form of pastoral activity is placed at risk if it does not rely on truly competent and trained personnel" (General Directory for Catechesis – for the Universal Church, n. 234). All those who hand on the Faith and those in leadership positions are to be working to complete their Basic Certification. When completed, certification folders are to be submitted to the Office to receive a certificate. The Diocesan standard for hours of training is 6 hours per year for parish catechists and 12 hours per year for catechetical leaders. If this is the first year for a parish to provide formation for catechists, begin with fewer hours but provide excellent training for personal growth for a deeper union with Jesus Christ.

RCIA – Assisting Participants to Understand Catholic Prayers

For people seeking to become Catholic through the RCIA process, it is essential to help them grow in their relationship with Jesus through daily, committed prayer. There is a Prayer Card for each: the Sign of the Cross, the Our Father, the Hail Mary, the Apostles' Creed etc. To download a Prayer Card, which focuses on going deeper in understanding one prayer while leading to personal conversation with Jesus, <u>click here</u>. Resources for each prayer include an explanation of the words, the basic principles underlying the prayer, the Scriptural foundation and other helpful aspects that help the words of the prayer to become a personal encounter with Jesus, or our Heavenly Father, or Mary.

Proper Handling of Monies - Review of parish/school accounts and financial control guidelines

In an effort to protect you and your volunteers, please read the Review of Parish/School Accounts and Financial Control Guidelines by <u>clicking here</u>. The section on Cash Receipts/Money Counting should be followed for all events within your Parish including but not limited to bazaars, raffles, outings, etc. Please ensure those responsible for oversight on each event is made aware of the policy and is following the guidelines established.

Simply put, the policy is asking all parishes to use the buddy system when collecting, counting and transporting money. To follow policy there needs to be two unrelated persons involved in the process. Please check with your parish finance secretary and pastor for the specific manner that your parish has in place to meet these guidelines.


Send your prayer intention to Bishop Callahan this Advent

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-</u>environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website.
