Reminder: Clergy Study Day on the revised Order of Baptism of Children

The Order of Baptism of Children, Second Edition is now available for purchase. It may be used as early as the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2; it must be used beginning Easter Sunday, April 12, 2020.

Workshops will be held for priests and deacons in three locations in February and March (a workshop for DRE's and other parish staff will be offered on another occasion in 2020):

- February 18 at St. Joseph Church in Stevens Point
- March 3 at St. Olaf Church in Eau Claire
- March 17 at St. Patrick Church in Onalaska

The day will begin at 10:30 and conclude by 3:00, and the schedule will include an in-depth look at the revised ritual (Chris Carstens), clarifications on frequently-asked canonical questions surrounding baptism (Vicars General), lunch, and a review of the second edition of the Diocesan baptismal preparation program (Ann Lankford).

The ritual text is available (in many cases in both English and Spanish) from <u>Catholic Book Publishing Company</u> (\$27.95), <u>USCCB Publishing</u> (\$44.95), <u>Liturgy Training Publications</u> (\$39.95), Liturgical Press (\$39.95), and <u>Magnificat</u> (\$29.95).

Reminder: Rite of Election Retreat, February 22

In preparation for the Rite of Election and of the Call to Continuing Conversion (March 1, 2020), many parishes (or groups of parishes) offer retreats for their catechumens and candidates. For those parishes that do not offer a retreat in the parish, there will be three retreats open to catechumens and candidates on the morning of Saturday, February 22: at St. Peter Parish in Stevens Point, St. Mary Parish in Altoona, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. Although schedules may vary slightly at each retreat site, the day will include Mass, three spiritual talks, time for reflection, and lunch. A site-specific schedule will be sent upon registration or upon request. Registration form is available here; deadline is February 14. Please encourage those in your RCIA process to reserve this date.

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord: Sunday, February 2

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord falls on a Sunday in 2020, and its celebration outranks a Sunday in Ordinary Time. As a reminder, the Roman Missal calls for the blessing of candles before Mass, with either a procession or solemn entrance occurring after the blessing. The faithful should be encouraged to bring candles to be blessed at the Mass. A parish can distribute candles to those in attendance, and the candles intended for the use of the church throughout the year might also be blessed at Masses on this day. DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. If you have any questions about the Diocese of La Crosse and the

implementation of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, please contact Teresa Brown, Diocese of La Crosse, at 608.791.2679; or tbrown@diolc.org.

Please check your parish and school's posting of the safe environment guidelines: —the most current announcement is above. This must be published in your parish bulletin at least once a quarter, and 2 bulletins need to be sent in with your yearly Safe Environment Report.

In all dioceses of the United States of America, January 22, shall be observed as a particular day of prayer for the full restoration of the legal guarantee of the right to life and of penance for violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion. The liturgical celebrations for this day may be the "Mass for Giving Thanks to God for the Gift of Human Life" (no. 48/1 of the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions), celebrated with white vestments, or the Mass "For the Preservation of Peace and Justice" (no. 30 of the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions), celebrated with violet vestments."

New Form W4 Effective January 1, 2020

The IRS has issued a new form W4 Employee's Withholding Certificate. Please <u>click here</u> for a PDF Fillable W4 form. Please <u>click here</u> for general questions/answers about the new W4 form. Bottom line is that for current employees you don't have to do anything. Only new employees or current employees who wish to make changes will need to use the new W4 form. If an employee is seeking help completing the form, it is always best to refer them to their tax professional. We can explain what information is needed to complete the form but should not offer tax advice

Church Mutual Nurse Triage Program

Catholic Mutual Group partners with Church Mutual for administration of the worker's compensation programs for the Diocese of La Crosse. As part of that program, Church Mutual offers a Nurse Triage Program through their partnership with Medcor. Medcor is an excellent, 24/7, free of charge resource that connects employers and employees with a medical professional who can advise treatment steps that an injured employee can take immediately following an injury to ensure employees get the care they need without unnecessary costs or delays. Catholic Mutual has packets that will be sent to each location with two packets being sent to those parishes with schools associated with their ledger page so each may have one. The packet contains the brochure about Medcor, a more detailed booklet, band-aid stickies for people's desks, and cards that can be detached and distributed.

All worker's compensation injury claims should continue to be reported directly to Kris Twining as you have in the past.
