This type of formation is being used throughout the country, and in 7 parishes/schools in the Diocese, with markedly noticeable fruits. Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception: December 9, 2019

Since December 8, 2019, is the Second Sunday of Advent, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is transferred to Monday, December 9, 2019. The obligation to attend Mass, however, does NOT transfer. The Optional Memorial of Saint Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin, December 9, is omitted this year. (From the USCCB)

Our Lady of Loreto added to Calendar: December 10

Pope Francis has decreed that the feast of Our Lady of Loreto be included in the Roman Calendar as an optional memorial on December 10. "This celebration," the decree notes, "will help all people, especially families, youth and religious to imitate the virtues of that perfect disciple of the Gospel, the Virgin Mother, who, in conceiving the Head of the Church also accepted us as her own." Read the decree from the Congregation for Divine Worship <u>here</u>. Until proper liturgical texts are translated, ritual texts for Our Lady of Loreto are taken from other parts of the Roman Missal, Lectionary, and Liturgy of the Hours: see the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship instructions <u>here</u> for details.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-</u>environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. Reminder: Dispose of all old forms- Please dispose of all old Safe Environment forms and begin using the new forms. Old Basic Background Check forms, without the disclaimer, are still being used. This form changed July 2018. Beginning January 1, 2020, any background checks sent on an old form will be rejected and sent back to your parish or school to be completed on the correct form. All background checks must be signed.

2019-20 Safe Environment Report: As of November 15, an email has been sent to all parishes and schools with their spreadsheet for the 2019-20 Safe Environment Report. Included in the email were the report forms and online training dates for staff and volunteers. If you have not received your spreadsheet, have questions or need more information, contact the Safe Environment Office.

Forms: <u>#4 Authorization for Release of FBI Information</u> is only used and returned with a completed set of fingerprint cards.

Errors being made on fingerprint cards: on the left side of the card, there is a space for employer and address. This is not the address of the Police Department, or the address of your volunteer's job. This space is for the address of the Parish or the School they are working or volunteering at.
