We have received several reports of targeted attacks by a crafted fake Gmail address, attempting to represent your pastor. There are two things you, and everyone that receives the scam message, can do.

1. Report the Gmail address used to send the phishing message to Google as a violation of the Gmail Program Policies and/or Terms of Use using this link: <u>https://support.google.com/mail/contact/abuse</u>

2. Report the phishing message by moving the message into your Spam folder and, if you are using Gmail, Open the message, Next to Reply, click More, and then click Report phishing. <u>https://support.google.com/mail/answer/8253?hl=en</u>

Thank you for your diligence and attention to these clever attacks.

Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception: December 9, 2019

Since December 8, 2019, is the Second Sunday of Advent, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is transferred to Monday, December 9, 2019. The obligation to attend Mass, however, does NOT transfer. The Optional Memorial of Saint Juan Diego Cuauhtlatoatzin, December 9, is omitted this year. (From the USCCB)

Our Lady of Loreto added to Calendar: December 10

Pope Francis has decreed that the feast of Our Lady of Loreto be included in the Roman Calendar as an optional memorial on December 10. "This celebration," the decree notes, "will help all people, especially families, youth and religious to imitate the virtues of that perfect disciple of the Gospel, the Virgin Mother, who, in conceiving the Head of the Church also accepted us as her own." Read the decree from the Congregation for Divine Worship here. Until proper liturgical texts are translated, ritual texts for Our Lady of Loreto are taken from other parts of the Roman Missal, Lectionary, and Liturgy of the Hours: see the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship instructions here for details.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-</u><u>environment/reporting</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>.
