Reminder: Clergy Study Day on the revised Order of Baptism of Children

The Order of Baptism of Children, Second Edition is now available for purchase. It may be used as early as the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2; it must be used beginning Easter Sunday, April 12, 2020.

Workshops will be held for priests and deacons in three locations in February and March (a workshop for DRE's and other parish staff will be offered on another occasion in 2020):

- March 3 at St. Olaf Church in Eau Claire
- March 17 at St. Patrick Church in Onalaska

The day will begin at 10:30 and conclude by 3:00, and the schedule will include an in-depth look at the revised ritual (Chris Carstens), clarifications on frequently-asked canonical questions surrounding baptism (Vicars General), lunch, and a review of the second edition of the Diocesan baptismal preparation program (Ann Lankford).

The ritual text is available (in many cases in both English and Spanish) from <u>Catholic Book Publishing Company</u> (\$27.95), <u>USCCB Publishing</u> (\$44.95), <u>Liturgy Training Publications</u> (\$39.95), Liturgical Press (\$39.95), and Magnificat (\$29.95).

Bishop Callahan asks that each pastor lead a Holy Hour for Penance and Healing on Saturday, February 22, in response to clergy sexual abuse and the public release of names of clergy with a substantiated allegation of child sexual abuse. Although the schedule may vary from parish to parish, the Holy Hour for Penance and Healing will begin at 2:00 p.m. and conclude at 3:00 p.m. Confessions will then be heard from this time until the beginning of Mass. Optional resources for the Holy Hour are available: presider's text (in Word or PDF); participant text (Word or PDF)); participant text formatted for printing back to back, then folded (Word or PDF)). Pastors should adapt the format or texts as appropriate.

Rite of Election Retreat: February 22

In preparation for the Rite of Election and of the Call to Continuing Conversion (March 1, 2020), many parishes (or groups of parishes) offer retreats for their catechumens and candidates. For those parishes that do not offer a retreat in the parish, there will be three retreats open to catechumens and candidates on the morning of Saturday, February 22: at St. Peter Parish in Stevens Point, St. Mary Parish in Altoona, and the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in La Crosse. Although schedules may vary slightly at each retreat site, the day will include Mass, three spiritual talks, time for reflection, and lunch. A site-specific schedule will be sent upon registration or upon request. Registration form is available here; deadline was February 14. Please encourage those in your RCIA process to reserve this date.

Liturgical Precautions During Flu Season

In light of the high incidence of influenza and the recent Coronavirus outbreak, Bishop Callahan asks all pastors and parochial administrators in the Diocese of La Crosse to use their own discretion about inviting the exchange of the Sign of Peace and the distribution of the Precious Blood from the chalice. Individual members of the faithful can also determine for themselves whether to exchange the Sign of Peace with their neighbors or to receive the Precious Blood from the chalice. If a significant change in the situation surrounding the incidences of either influenza or Coronavirus occurs, further direction will be offered.

Prayer for the Intercession of Blessed Brother James Miller, FSC

February 13, 2020, marked the first annual observance of the feast day of Blessed James Miller. A prayer for his intercession has been approved by Bishop Callahan:

"O Blessed Brother James Miller, you heard God's call to become a Brother of the Christian Schools and so became a sign of faith to youth in the United States and in Central America. You placed your life and your trust in Divine Providence and, for spreading the faith, merited the crown of martyrdom. In a world that denies the dignity of the human person, obtain for us from Divine Providence an ever increasing love of God and our neighbor, especially the poor and oppressed. Obtain for us also the favor we are now asking for [mention request] and the grace and strength to be a witness to Christ's love to all. Amen."

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse

Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Who is locking up at the end of day?

If you have religious ed students in the building waiting for rides, there must be supervision waiting with them. The same for athletes. Coaches must stay on premise until the last student athlete leaves the building or practice field. You can't leave children alone in a building expecting your maintenance staff to lock up at the end of the evening. Team up and use the buddy system so there is never one adult alone with one child. 2 teachers or 2 coaches stay until the end and lock up, or wait for all children to leave the premise before they go home.

There are 40 complete parish and 8 complete school reports as of 2-18-20. Remember March 1 is approaching fast. If you need an extension, please contact Teresa Brown.

There have been many questions about the compensation for priests. Please <u>click here</u> for the Decree Promulgating Norms for the Compensation of the Clergy that you can refer to. Please note, stipends for Mass offerings are taxable and payments for the stipends should be processed through payroll. The allowances that a priest receives for travel, room and board are all taxable. If a priest documents his travel and submits a log to be reimbursed at the set mileage rate by the parish, then the travel reimbursement is not taxable.
