Q: What are the time commitments?

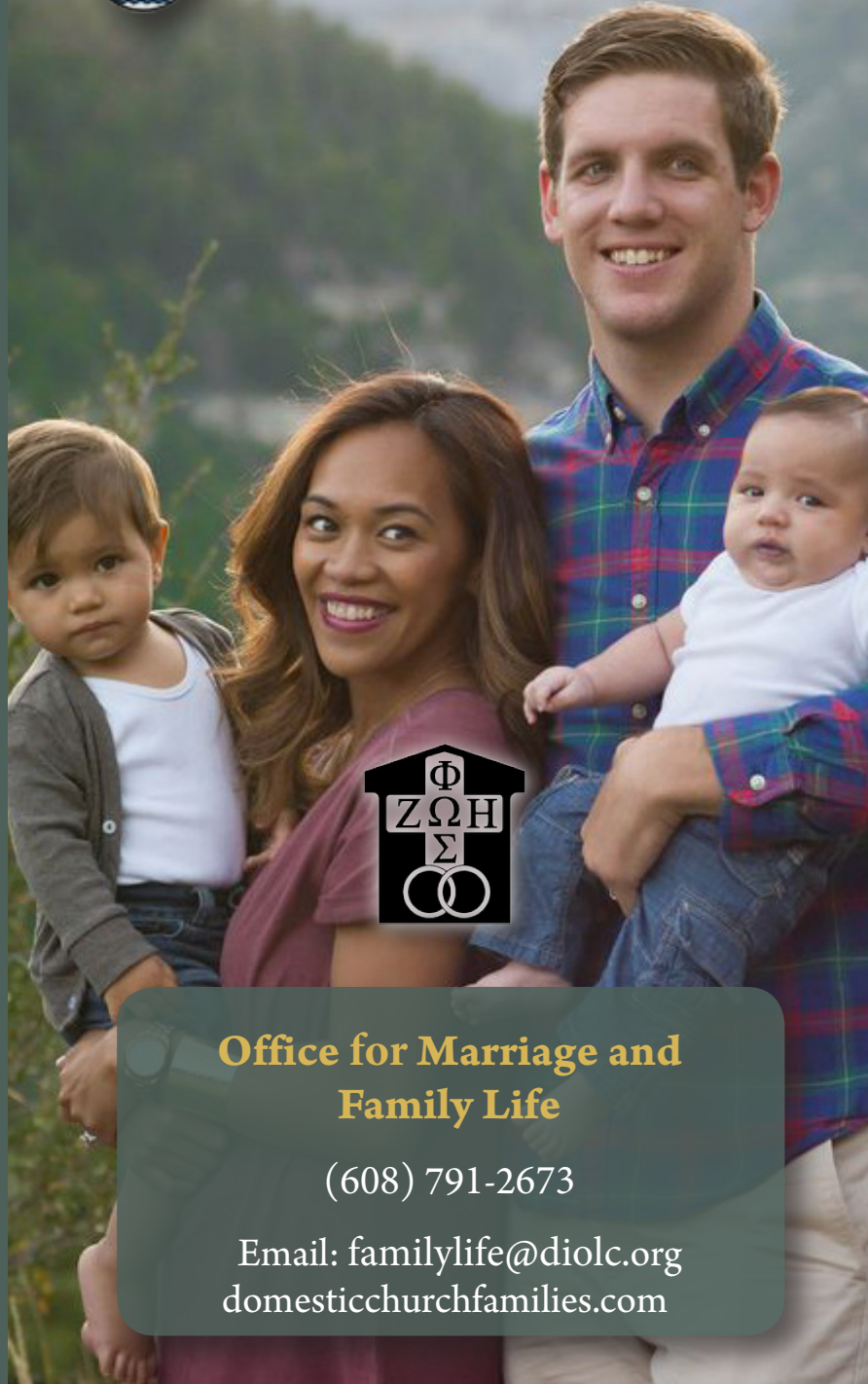
A: One of the best aspects of Domestic Church is couples only meet with their circles once a month, and the rest of the work is done at home with your spouse and family.

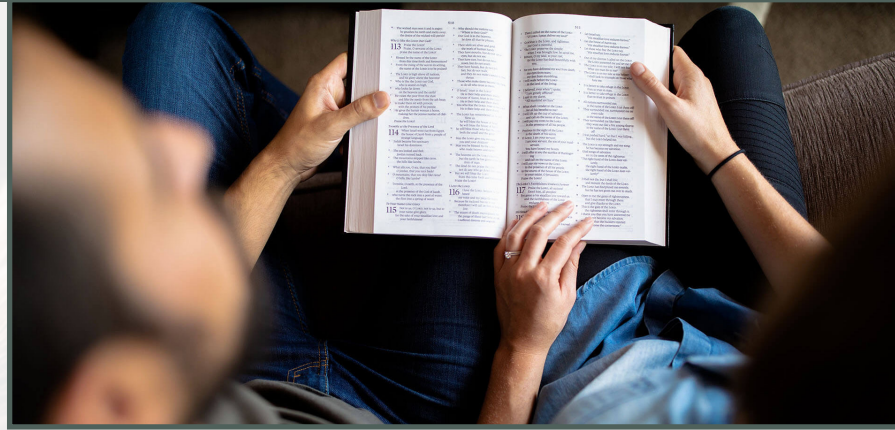
DOMESTIC CHURCH

PRAYER

Daily individual, couple and family prayer helps you, your spouse and your family grow in relationship with God.



STUDY OF SCRIPTURE

Daily reflection on the living word of God will help you to recognize and respond to the inspirations of the Holy Spirit. There is no particular scripture assigned to reflect on, just an invitation for you to open the Bible each day.
