THE DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

The particular souls prayed for on each day of the novena are:

- DAY 1 (Good Friday) — All mankind, especially sinners
- DAY 2 (Holy Saturday) — The souls of priests and religious
- DAY 3 (Easter Sunday) — All devout and faithful souls
- DAY 4 (Easter Monday) — Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know Him
- DAY 5 (Easter Tuesday) — The souls of separated brethren
- DAY 6 (Easter Wednesday) — The meek and humble souls and the souls of children
- DAY 7 (Easter Thursday) — The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy
- DAY 8 (Easter Friday) — The souls who are detained in purgatory;
- DAY 9 (Easter Saturday) — The souls who have become lukewarm.

On the Hail Mary beads, pray: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Ten times)

Repeat for the next four Decades

On the Our Father beads, pray:

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
