Reminder: Parish Catechetical Leaders – Catechist Formation

The Virtual Conference with Fr. Timothy Gallagher is a great way to provide ongoing catechist training that is necessary. The spiritual life of the catechist is the most important aspect of catechist formation as they (and we) must be deepening our relationship with Jesus Christ to be authentic witnesses. Every person faces discouragement, which is the greatest obstacle to the spiritual life. Based upon his book, *Overcoming Spiritual Discouragement*, Fr. Gallagher will help us find freedom from this obstacle. You are invited to gather with your catechists at your parish on August 29th to hear from Fr. Gallagher – a spiritual master – by live-streamed ZOOM webinar. The discussion and lunch-time conversation are an important part of the conference and an antidote to the isolation caused by COVID-19.

Planning for Fall – First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

For the benefit of second-grade children, it is recommended that First Confession be received during the fall, such as during Advent. As usual, First Holy Communion may be received in spring. If both Sacraments are received in close proximity, the preparation for one Sacrament will be greatly deficient, as children in second grade are unable to process the preparation for two Sacraments at one time. Further, when the second graders receive First Reconciliation in the fall, they may receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation several times before receiving their First Holy Communion. This practice will help them develop the habit of going to confession on a regular basis.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the diocesan website. Revision to Priests' Salary Schedule

As indicated in the June 16 Chancery Bulletin, the <u>Priests' Salary Schedule 2020-2021</u> was made available on the Diocese of La Crosse website. Due to the impact of COVID-19 pandemic affecting the diocese, priest's salaries were not increased for cost of living adjustment, however, priest's ordination steps should continue to be applied. The Presbyteral Council recommended that no increase should be given to the priests for the fiscal year 2021. The bishop accepted their recommendation. Effective July 1, 2020 an increase to the priest salary would not be provided. The Decree Compensation of the Clergy was not updated since the change was only for fiscal year 2021.
