Virtual Conference featuring Father Timothy Gallagher – Saturday, August 29th

Back by popular demand, Father Gallagher will be presenting on his book, *Overcoming Spiritual Discouragement*, at the Virtual Conference on **Saturday**, **August 29**<sup>th</sup>. One of the greatest obstacles in life is spiritual discouragement or discouragement in general. Join with a group at your parish for this live-streamed ZOOM webinar, or watch in your own home with a few people, to discuss this most important topic necessary for growth in the spiritual life. The virtual conference with Father Timothy Gallagher is a great way to provide necessary ongoing catechist training. The spiritual life of the catechist is the most important aspect of catechist formation as they (and we) must be deepening our relationship with Jesus Christ to be authentic witnesses. Every person faces discouragement, which is the greatest obstacle to the spiritual life. Based upon his book, *Overcoming Spiritual Discouragement*, Father Gallagher will help us find freedom from this obstacle. ## First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

For the benefit of second-grade children, it is recommended that First Confession be received during the fall, and First Holy Communion be received in spring. If both sacraments are received in close proximity, the preparation for one sacrament will be greatly deficient, as children in second grade are unable to process the preparation for two sacraments at one time. Further, when the second graders receive First Reconciliation in the fall, they can go to confession several times before receiving their First Holy Communion. This practice will help with developing the habit of going to confession on a regular basis.

#### Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saturday, August 15, 2020

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary will be celebrated on Saturday, August 15, 2020 (it is not a holy day of obligation this year). Masses of anticipation on Saturday evening ought to use readings and orations from the 20th Sunday of Ordinary Time. Wedding Masses on August 15 must use readings and orations from the Mass for the Assumption, "with inclusion of the Nuptial Blessing and, if appropriate, the proper formula for the final blessing" (Order for Celebrating Matrimony, 34). Still, one of the readings may be taken from the Order of Matrimony (ibid.). Evening Prayer should be taken from EP II of the Assumption.

#### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or <a href="mailto:intakeagent@diolc.org">intakeagent@diolc.org</a>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <a href="mailto:diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting">diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting</a>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <a href="mailto:diocesan website">diocesan website</a>.
