Mission Co-op Program (MCP) Follow-up: We are very grateful to many pastors who are doing Mission Co-op appeals on behalf of missionaries who are unable to travel because of COVID restrictions and other pastors who are having trouble finding help-outs for their parishes in the diocese. Although some appeals have needed to be scheduled into the fall, please remember they are not to be made on World Mission Sunday (Oct. 17-18, 2020, designated for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith annual collection) or on the weekends designated for the launching of the Diocesan Annual Appeal for your parishes.

We appreciate all the kind and creative assistance given during this difficult time! The Mission Office and missionaries realize that the appeals this summer will not generate the same kind of income we may have become accustomed to in "normal" times. However, we are hoping that appeals will be completed under the changed circumstances for a few reasons:

1. Mission territories do not have the same recovery mechanisms we have enjoyed here. The pandemic has caused us some hardship, but in many other places it evolves more quickly into life and death decisions. The ministry of bishops and religious superiors are seriously stifled by the pandemic and your assistance means more now than ever.

2. There are parishioners who want to offer their support to mission territories of the world. The Mission Co-op is a trusted way to offer that support without follow-up database building and further solicitation. For many it is an attractive way to give and feel part of the "solution."

3. The Mission Co-op is an ongoing program from the Society for the Propagation of the Faith that is personal and effective. Missing one year makes a difference in the experience of the people. It becomes more difficult to reboot a program they don't remember.

MCP Note to Parish Pastors and Staff: Thank you to pastors who consider these points while hosting missionaries or appealing to others on their behalf.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Karen Becker, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Becker at 608.791.0179 or <u>intakeagent@diolc.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-</u> <u>environment/reporting</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. Explosion in Beirut – You Can Help

On August 4, a massive explosion rocked Beirut, Lebanon, injuring more than 5,000 and killing at least 137. Officials are still evacuating residents, while trying to grasp the cost in human life and misery. Along with Caritas Lebanon, Catholic Relief Services (CRS) is distributing emergency supplies, clearing rubble, and preparing medical and mental health teams for dispatch. Your donation can help. Ask Congress to Include Non-Public Schools as Recipients of Emergency Aid

Several U.S. Bishops co-signed an <u>Aug. 5 letter</u> to congressional leaders, which reads in part: "As you consider additional aid to help Americans through the [pandemic] crisis, we implore you to ensure that the education needs of all children are met, including children in Catholic and other nonpublic schools ... The most effective way to help struggling families stay attached to their schools is to fund emergency tuition scholarships for low-income families to use at Catholic or other non-public schools."
