Up to Four Masses on Christmas Eve, Four on Christmas Day

Bishop Callahan has decreed that Christmas Eve Masses can begin as early as 2:00 p.m. on December 24, 2020. The earlier time will allow, where it is deemed appropriate by the pastor, for priests to offer additional Masses on Christmas Eve to accommodate the faithful, while still keeping overall occupancy numbers below 25%.

Relative to this decree about the start time of Christmas Eve Masses is a further decree from Cardinal Robert Sarah of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. For the year 2020, he says, Bishops may allow their priests to celebrate four Masses (rather than three) on Christmas Eve, and four more on Christmas day. Bishop Callahan will grant this permission in a forthcoming decree.

In short: priests may begin to celebrate Christmas Eve Masses as early as 2:00 p.m. on December 24. They may offer four Masses on December 24, and four more Masses on December 25. Please contact the Office for Sacred Worship with any questions.

U.S. Bishops' Statement on ethics of COVID-19 Vaccines

There are currently three vaccines that are likely to be made available in the coming months, those from Pfizer, Moderna, and AstraZeneca. Neither Pfizer nor Moderna used morally compromised cell lines in producing the vaccine. A confirmatory test, however, employing the commonly used, but morally compromised HEK293 cell line (from kidney cells taken from an aborted child in the Netherlands in 1972) was performed on both vaccines. Thus, while neither vaccine is completely free from any connection to morally compromised cell lines, in this case the connection is very remote from the initial evil of the abortion. The AstraZeneca vaccine is more morally compromised. The HEK293 cell line was used in the design, development, and production stages of that vaccine, as well as for confirmatory testing. Where possible, then, the Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are to be used instead. Where that is not possible or would mean significant delay, the AstraZeneca vaccine may be used, in the same way that the Rubella vaccine is used because there is no alternative. Thursday, December 17 - PNQ project launch webinars for QuickBooks Online and ParishSOFT Accounting.

We are transitioning all parishes to a new standard Chart of Accounts during 2021, the PNQ project outlined during the recent finance webinar. Expected benefits include a much easier Annual Report, greater accounting transparency, and improved parish software support.

For parishes wishing to use QuickBooks, please be aware that the 80% discount for QBO will expire at year-end. This discount will save parishes using the QBO software \$56/month, or \$3,360 over the next five years. If your parish wishes to participate in the QBO discount program, please advise Nick Lichter nlichter@diolc.org today, Tuesday, December 15, 2020. Parishes who have not contacted us by the end of business on December 15 will not be able to participate in the QBO 80% discount.
