








EXTERIOR OF CATHEDRAL

- Control joints in masonry
- Gutter repair
- Replace metal cap


WHEN IS COMMITMENT WEEKEND?

- You will also receive suggested posts for FaceBook and Twitter from the Office for Communications



HOW DO I HOST A COMMITMENT WEEKEND?

- The Commitment Weekend appeal takes place in lieu of the homily during all weekend Masses.
- Materials are provided to help guide the structure of your appeal.
 - An informative campaign video can be shown to provide details of the campaign need
 - Additional talking points will be provided to support the video appeal
 - Campaign materials delivered to your parish will include more information on the campaign and provide parishioners with a means to pledge
 - Invite Ushers, Greeters or other volunteers to assist
