All clergy of the Diocese of La Crosse are able to obtain a free, professional and secure email account. Given the many email scams and counterfeits we see weekly, it is recommended that all clergy use an email with the diocesan domain diolclergy.org or at least one from their parish. Keep in mind a diolclergy.org email address is highly available, portable and moves with you as you move between assignments. The diolclergy.org domain is part of the diocesan GSuite. Your diolclergy.org account will include the full range of G Suite functionality.

Simply send me a message indicating you would like to get a diolclergy.org email account setup and I'll take it from there.

It is recommended that all parish and school staff eliminate the use of free domains such as Gmail, Hotmail, Yahoo, or domains from their Internet provider and other such services when representing the diocese/parish/school via email correspondence. Adherence to this recommendation will establish an authenticity of the correspondence and reduce the potential for misrepresentation or impersonation.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its [policies and procedures](#), seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the [diocesan website](#). If you have any questions about the Diocese of La Crosse and the implementation of the *Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People*, please contact Teresa Brown, Diocese of La Crosse, at 608.791.2679 or tbrown@diolc.org.

A packet has been mailed with the most current Protect and Heal (Safe Environment) materials to each parish. Current forms, the poster and the bulletin message were included in the packet. Destroy all old forms and begin using the new ones immediately. As a reminder, the FBI release form is included on the Basic Background Renewal form now.

What is the difference between Protect and Heal and Safe Environment? Protect and Heal is the name of the program and the training given to children and adults in the Diocese of La Crosse. Safe Environment is the name of the office which provides the training and resources for the program.
