- On the right, click on the middle blue button: "My parish or school is already registered, and I would like to set up my individual free account under that institution." This will allow you to create a free account under your Parish or school.
- 3. The last step in creating an account will be to select your Diocese from a drop-down menu, and then your parish / school from a second drop-down menu, listed by city and name. Once you have finished by clicking on the "Sign Up" button, you will then have a dashboard, which will enable you to select from the variety of tracks. A track is a grouping of workshops. Select a track on the left, and then enter one (or more than one if you wish).

Guidelines for preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation are spelled out in **Bishop Callahan's Letter on Confirmation**, as well as the **Confirmation brochure** for the Diocese. From these documents you will see that four components are needed:

1) Evangelization is needed during this preparation as every student in high school needs to begin understanding the Faith at a deeper level, by having their questions answered and personally engaging with the Faith.

All clergy of the Diocese of La Crosse are able to obtain a free, professional and secure email account. Given the many email scams and counterfeits we see weekly, it is recommended that all clergy use an email with the diocesan domain <u>diolclergy.org</u> or at least one from their Parish. Keep in mind a <u>diolclergy.org</u> email address is highly available, portable and moves with you as you move between assignments. The <u>diolclergy.org</u> domain is part of the diocesan GSuite. Your <u>diolclergy.org</u> account will include the full range of G Suite functionality.

Simply send me a message indicating you would like to get a <u>diolclergy.org</u> email account setup and I'll take it from there.

It is recommended that all parish and school staff eliminate the use of free domains such as Gmail, Hotmail, Yahoo, or domains from their Internet provider and other such services when representing the diocese/parish/school via email correspondence. Adherence to this recommendation will establish an authenticity of the correspondence and reduce the potential for misrepresentation or impersonation.



- Marquette, this sympto-hormonal method is taught by a parishioner in the Chippewa Falls Deanery either face-to-face or virtually.
- Creitghton, this sympto only medical model method is taught by a parishioner in the Stevens Point Deanery either face-to-face or virtually.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-</u>environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>.
