Deepen Your Faith

Free subscription to Franciscan At Home Learning System

All parishes and schools have a free subscription to *Franciscan At Home* learning system by way of generous donors. The format of each workshop is ten-minute videos, followed by an application task, with the spiritual life of the learner at the heart of the formation.

Feature workshop: The Father: Origin and Desire of All presented by Dr. Petroc Willey

It is for the sake of showing us the Father that Jesus took flesh and lived among us, and to enable us to share in His own relationship with Him. Jesus' coming among us has enabled us to receive the spirit of sonship, so that we can now cry, as children of the Father, "Abba! Father!" (see Romans 8:15 and Galatians 4:6).

Thus, we can enter this workshop in a spirit of profound thanksgiving, since knowing the Father and His love is the eternal life we have been promised (see John 17:3). This is our inheritance. There are six 10-minute videos to this workshop.

Below are simple directions to onboard Franciscan At Home.

1. Visit <u>franciscanathome.com/diocese-la-crosse</u> and scroll to the bottom of the page.

2. On the right, click on the middle blue button: "My parish or school is already registered, and I would like to set up my individual free account under that institution." This will allow you to create a FREE account under your parish or school.

3. Then click "Create an Account." Complete the information and click Save. Select the Diocese of La Crosse from a drop-down menu, and then your institution = your parish / school from a second drop-down menu, listed by city and name. Once you have finished by clicking on the "Sign Up" button, you will have a dashboard. This will enable you to select from the variety of tracks. A track is a grouping of workshops. Select a track on the left, and then enter it to see the various workshops.

Formation for Catechists: Franciscan at Home Online Learning

Catechists are to receive six hours of formation every year, for the duration of their service. Make use of excellent online workshops through *Franciscan at Home*.

Pandemic Information for the Fall

Regarding the COVID-19 / delta variant and the fall Faith Formation Program, no mandates are planned. At this time, we are asking all of our parishes to make sure you are working with your local county health department to plan a safe Faith Formation year. Votive Mass for Blessed Michael McGivney

Father Michael McGivney, founder of the Knights of Columbus and priest of the Archdiocese of Hartford, was beatified on October 31, 2020. Normally, a blessed is celebrated liturgically only if he or she is inscribed in the calendar of a diocese. Since Blessed McGivney is not on our Diocesan calendar, his August 13 feast day is not observed locally. However, and by way of exception, the Holy See has permitted that "gatherings of Knights [may] celebrate a votive Mass in honor of Father McGivney with the permission of the local ordinary and respecting the rules of precedence laid out in the Table of Liturgical Days." In short, if a priest wishes to celebrate a votive Mass in honor of Blessed Michael McGivney for a group of Knights of Columbus—whether on August 13 or on any day that the liturgical calendar allows—he should request permission from the bishop and proper texts will be forwarded to him.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safeenvironment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the diocesan website. At this writing, nearly all of our parishes have successfully launched their parish accounting transition. We have communicated with those few parishes not yet launched and are confident of having transition underway soon. A huge thank you to all parish accounting staff and pastors. Congratulations and well done to all of you!

Important notice regarding parishsoft accounting!

- Transactional access to the old database (lacrosse.parishsoftaccounting.com) will end September 30, 2021 for all parishes per the contract with ParishSOFT.
- View only access, including report capabilities, to the old database (lacrosse.parishsoftaccounting.com), will continue until January 31, 2022.
- Finance Office access by request will continue until September 30, 2023.

Effectively this means that parishes using ParishSOFT accounting must complete all fiscal year 2020-2021 transactional activity in the old database before September 30, 2021. Failure to complete all parish transactional activity in the old database before September 30, 2021 may require intervention from ParishSOFT Support at a rate of \$250/hour, which will be billed to your parish.
