Reminder: BEET Grants deadline Friday, January 28, 2022

The purpose of the Bishop's Education Endowment Trust (BEET) is to support and assist the mission of the Diocese of La Crosse in providing funds for all aspects of Catholic education and are based upon need.

The method for applying for the BEET grant for the 2022-23 fiscal year has changed from a paper application to completing an online Google Forms (application). Because the process is new, please allow yourself extra time to familiarize yourself with the new process, review the application questions and set aside time to complete the Google Form (application). The online form makes reading applications easier for all of the grant reviewers and dramatically reduces the time it takes to process the grants for review. The deadline for submission and approval is Friday, January 28, 2022.

When the old ways aren't working, the Retrouvaille Program helps couples restore their marriages and rebuild loving relationships. This is a three-phase program that begins with a weekend stay in the Wausau area. A series of "post sessions" provide ongoing healing and support. Friendly Reminder - Mission Co-op Program (MCP) 2021 and World Mission Sunday 2021:

Please send the Mission Office any outstanding collections for Mission Coop appeals given this past summer and also for World Mission Sunday (October 24, 2021). Our missionaries are suffering extra hardships due to the pandemic, and some disbursements are being delayed due to non-receipt of some parishes' collections. Thank you for your generous prayerful and monetary support.

Mission Co-op Program Summer 2022: The assignment of missionaries to parishes usually takes place for us at the end of January and beginning of February. Many requests and applications are in and being organized. So here are some last-minute notes for missionaries and pastors:

- **Missionaries/International priests:** Many thanks to all who have completed the annual application process. If you have confirmed your diocese or religious order, all is set. If you are unsure if your bishop or religious superior has completed the [application process](#), please have him submit the application by January 31, 2022 to ensure you are not missed for 2022. A new application must be submitted each year, even if you have been in our program previous years.
- **Pastors:** If you have any special requests re: which MCP missionary to be assigned this summer to your Parish (es), please let us know as soon as possible. We try during the assignment process to accommodate any particular mission request or 'exceptions to the rule' request. For example, the appeals are usually to be held in the months of June, July, August, but exceptions can be made with certain precautions. The specific weekend date of the appeal is mutually arranged between you and the missionary, but we can sometimes help with the flexibility charism of the missionary group, if possible. The Diocese of La Crosse, through its [policies and procedures](#), seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the [diocesan website](#). A native of Stevens Point and a De La Salle Christian Brother and missionary, Brother James Miller was gunned down while repairing a wall at the school where he worked in Huehuetenango, Guatemala on Feb. 13, 1982. He was declared a martyr and beatified by Pope Francis on Dec. 7, 2019. He stands as an example of fidelity to the Gospel and humble and fearless service on behalf of the poor and the vulnerable.
