# Children developing an authentic, faithful relationship with Jesus Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

Please consider taking time, over the next year, to visit one of the 14 parishes in the diocese to observe children involved in a session of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd. The method of Catechesis of the Good Shepherd began with Maria Montessori, and was continued by Sofia Cavalletti, a Hebrew and Scripture scholar, and her colleague Gianna Gobbi, both Roman Catholics. They discovered that children need the sensitive guidance of the adult and the inner guidance of the Holy Spirit to nurture their relationship with God. The adult prepares the sacred space for children, called the Atrium, which allows them a quiet, prayerful place to learn to listen and respond to a relationship with God through Jesus the Good Shepherd.

Everything in the Atrium looks either to Sacred Scripture or to Liturgy. In the Atrium, Christ is the teacher; the catechist is an instrument. Contact Ann Lankford at <a href="mailto:alankford@diolc.org">alankford@diolc.org</a> for a list of the parishes or schools with an Atrium in your area.

#### DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or <a href="mailto:intakeagent@diolc.org">intakeagent@diolc.org</a>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <a href="mailto:diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting">diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting</a>. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.
