New Catechetical Leader Training will be held in September in La Crosse. Join us as we have a helpful and enjoyable day planned with prayer, introductions, timely topics and to answer your questions. Further details and a registration form to follow.

Ongoing Formation of Catechists and Catechetical Leaders is Necessary

Catechetical Leaders are reminded that all catechists are to receive 6 hours of formation per year and DREs, CREs and Youth Ministers are to receive 12 hours of formation per year. A proven way to complete this formation is through **Franciscan at Home** online workshops. We have received great feedback from learners and so a generous donor has paid for every parish and school to have another free subscription from June 2022-2023. Each workshop is worth 4 hours of certification. It is best when the workshops are completed with a group. Simple directions to register for *Franciscan at Home* for free:

1) Visit <u>franciscanathome.com/diocese-la-crosse</u> and scroll to the bottom of the page.

2) On the right, click the middle blue button: **"My parish or school is already registered, and I** would like to set up my individual free account..."

3) Click "Create an Account." Complete the information and click "Save." Select the Diocese of La Crosse from a drop-down menu, and then your Institution: your parish / school, listed by city and name. Finally, click on the "Sign Up" button; you will have a dashboard. Scroll down to "Franciscan Tracks" on the left and select "Catechist" Track. In this Track, you will see 3 choices under Courses of Study. Click on "Foundational Catechist Certification" and you will see listings under "Workshops" and "Electives." Choose a workshop that will be most helpful for you and your catechists. There is much to learn in each workshop. A good time frame for these workshops is 1 hour increments, covering 2 videos and 2 application tasks, or 1 ½ hour increments, covering 3 videos and 3 applications tasks. 6 suggested workshops:

• Prayer: Introduction to the Spiritual Life of the Catechist with Dr. Ron Bolster. 3 - 1 hour sessions

- Introducing the Scriptures to Children with Dr. Gerard O'Shea. 4 1 hour sessions
- Penance and First Eucharist Preparation with Dr. Bill Keimig. 4 1 hour sessions
- Sacred Scripture: The Big Picture with Ann Lankford. 3 1 hour sessions
- Introducing the Liturgy to Children with Dr. Gerard O'Shea. 3 1 hour sessions
- Jesus: The Christocentricity of Catechesis (Christ-centered Catechesis) with Dr. Petroc Willey. 4 1 hour sessions

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to

make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or <u>intakeagent@diolc.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities.** Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the <u>diocesan website</u>. New for Parishes: beginning this audit period for 2022-2023, it has been recommended by the USCCB that the Diocese of La Crosse begin background checks for Eucharistic Ministers who are ministering to the homebound. Please begin adding them to your parish reports beginning with the 2022-23 Annual Report and begin background checks and training for them as soon as you are able.

The online training program has been updated. It can be found on the Diocese of La Crosse website at: <u>https://diolc.org/safe-environment/training/</u>.

Training consists of watching the video once, reading the red and green books and reviewing the new slide presentation. The program has been enhanced to add more topics. You can not complete the Diocese of La Crosse training in less than 10 minutes, so please advise people to set aside 30 minutes to complete the program. I will continue to send email notifications of those that have completed training weekly, but I will highlight times less than 10 minutes. You will need to contact these people and tell them they need to complete the course again.
