Scroll down to "Franciscan Tracks" under "Start Learning" on the left and select the "Catechist Track" (A Track is a collection of workshops.) Click on "Start this track." Click on "Foundational Catechist Track, and then "Contemporary Teaching Strategies" for a helpful workshop. Small groups are the ideal way to experience workshops.

DIOCESE OF LA CROSSE GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its <u>policies and procedures</u>, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, P.O. Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or <u>intakeagent@diolc.org</u>. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: <u>diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting</u>. **Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities**. Givingtrend Issues:

Due to system enhancements being pushed out in intermittent frequency, some users are encountering issues with their sign-on. If you are having a problem, the vendor recommends two methods that have proven effective in remedying the issues.

You will see your profile button in the upper right of the screen. Click on that and log out, then log back in. This usually helps clear any issues with viewing the data.

The second method is to log out as per the above fix. However, this time you will want to clear your browser cache via your browser settings, close your browser, reopen your browser and then log back into Givingtrend.
