Evenings of Recollection

The personal cost inherent in building the Kingdom of God in this world is addressed in many ways throughout the New Testament. Luke presents the teachings of Jesus on the subject through His 'sayings of discipleship' (Luke 14:25-35) which challenge us to self-emptying practices. St. Paul describes himself as "being poured out like a libation" (2 Timothy 4:6) as he examines his life's work and looks to his final sacrifice.

The cost to us as priests living among our parishioners and working out in the general public is clear. A declining interest in religion and the practice of faith obscures and diminishes the reward that fervent parishioners can bring to a pastor's heart. The increase of work and responsibility concentrated on one person can overwhelm the best of intentions. I could go on, but what is more vitally important is the fact that resources are needed for clergy to find healthy and holy ways to remain connected to Christ and to one another. The essential three are always present: prayer, spiritual direction and fraternity. But even when all these are habitual, they may not be enough to sustain us. Now is as good a time as any to seek more.

The idea for 'Evenings of Recollection' was initiated at the Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Plans then expanded to serve a wider geography within the diocese. At this point, two locations will offer this opportunity to priests. Then we will evaluate and plan according to feedback. The Shrine and Holy
